Scripts Program - Ruth briefly mentioned it to Mr. Pires. The MSHSA would like to pre-purchase popular gift cards to sell at the High School. Eileen Kalukin and Beth Donovan are looking to pre-buy \$500 worth of cards. A motion was made to approve giving money to this fundraising effort. Approved
